**US Army Corps of Engineers RPEC & Tulsa District Contracting Processes:
Task Order Requirement Notices (TORN)**

On October 20, 2020, the Tulsa Post, SAME hosted a USACE and Industry Panel Discussion regarding the process and background for the Task Order Requirements Notice (TORN) for Architect-Engineer Contractor selection. USACE presented a brief overview of the federal acquisition regulations and the Engineering Publication that outlines the selection process for A-Es and then highlighted the reasons /rationale for implementing the TORN process. The industry representatives discussed industry impacts and perspectives related to the new guidance.
